

## JESUS CHRIST

[Jhn 1:14 ESV] 14 And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth.

[Mat 1:21 ESV] 21 She will bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins."

[1Jo 4:9 ESV] 9 In this the love of God was made manifest among us, that God sent his only Son into the world, so that we might live through him.

[Rom 5:6 ESV] 6 For while we were still weak, at the right time Christ died for the ungodly.

[Isa 53:3-5 NIV] 3 He was despised and rejected by mankind, a man of suffering, and familiar with pain. Like one from whom people hide their faces he was despised, and we held him in low esteem. 4 Surely he took up our pain and bore our suffering, yet we considered him punished by God, stricken by him, and afflicted. 5 But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was on him, and by his wounds we are healed.

[2Co 5:18-19 NIV] 18 All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation: 19 that God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting people's sins against them. And he has committed to us the message of reconciliation.

[Jhn 3:16-17 ESV] 16 "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life. 17 For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him.

[Phi 2:6-8 ESV] 6 who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, 7 but emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men. 8 And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.

[Act 4:11 ESV] 11 This Jesus is the stone that was rejected by you, the builders, which has become the cornerstone.

[1Co 15:3-4 ESV] 3 For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received: that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, 4 that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures,

[Luk 24:6-7 ESV] 6 He is not here, but has risen. Remember how he told you, while he was still in Galilee, 7 that the Son of Man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men and be crucified and on the third day rise."

[Psa 89:27 ESV] 27 And I will make him the firstborn, the highest of the kings of the earth.

[Col 1:15-18 ESV] 15 He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation. 16 For by him all things were created, in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities--all things were created through him and for him. 17 And he is before all things, and in him all things hold together. 18 And he is the head of the body, the church. He is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in everything he might be preeminent.

[Rom 8:29 ESV] 29 For those whom he foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son, in order that he might be the firstborn among many brothers.

[Rev 1:4-6 NIV] ... Grace and peace to you from him who is, and who was, and who is to come, and from the seven spirits before his throne, 5 and from Jesus Christ, who is the faithful witness, the firstborn from the dead, and the ruler of the kings of the earth. To him who loves us and has freed us from our sins by his blood, 6 and has made us to be a kingdom and priests to serve his God and Father--to him be glory and power for ever and ever! Amen.

[Heb 12:22-25 NIV] 22 But you have come to Mount Zion, to the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem. You have come to thousands upon thousands of angels in joyful assembly, 23 to the church of the firstborn, whose names are written in heaven. You have come to God, the Judge of all, to the spirits of the righteous made perfect, 24 to Jesus the mediator of a new covenant, and to the sprinkled blood that speaks a better word than the blood of Abel. 25 See to it that you do not refuse him who speaks.

[1Co 8:5-6 NIV] 5 For even if there are so-called gods, whether in heaven or on earth (as indeed there are many "gods" and many "lords"), 6 yet for us there is but one God, the Father, from whom all things came and for whom we live; and there is but one Lord, Jesus Christ, through whom all things came and through whom we live.

[1Ti 2:5 ESV] 5 For there is one God, and there is one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus,

[Phl 4:19 ESV] 19 And my God will supply every need of yours according to his riches in glory in Christ Jesus.

[1Co 15:57 ESV] 57 But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

[Col 2:9-10 ESV] 9 For in him the whole fullness of deity dwells bodily, 10 and you have been filled in him, who is the head of all rule and authority.

[Jhn 14:18 ESV] 18 "I will not leave you as orphans; I will come to you.

[Jhn 10:9 ESV] 9 I am the door. If anyone enters by me, he will be saved and will go in and out and find pasture.

[Luk 19:10 ESV] 10 For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost."

[Jhn 8:12 ESV] 12 Again Jesus spoke to them, saying, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life."

[Mar 10:45 ESV] 45 For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many."

[1Jo 5:5 ESV] 5 Who is it that overcomes the world except the one who believes that Jesus is the Son of God?

[Phl 1:6 ESV] 6 And I am sure of this, that he who began a good work in you will bring it to completion at the day of Jesus Christ.

[Gal 5:1 ESV] 1 For freedom Christ has set us free; stand firm therefore, and do not submit again to a yoke of slavery.

[1Jo 5:11 ESV] 11 And this is the testimony, that God gave us eternal life, and this life is in his Son.
