

THE LORD IS GOOD AND HE IS WORTHY TO BE PRAISED!

HIS LOVE FOR YOU IS GREAT & HE ONLY HAS GOOD THINGS FOR YOU!

(These scriptures have been personalized to help you receive God's truth in your heart.)

Psalm 106:1 I praise the LORD. I give thanks to the LORD, for He is good; His love endures forever.

Proverbs 8:17 God loves me who loves Him, and I who seek Him diligently find Him.

Jeremiah 29:11 God has plans to prosper me, not to harm me, plans to give me hope and a future.

Psalm 136:26 I give thanks to the God of heaven, for His steadfast love endures forever.

Psalm 89:1 I will sing of the LORD's great love forever; with my mouth I will make His faithfulness known through all generations.

Psalm 89:2 I will declare that your love stands firm forever, that you established your faithfulness in heaven itself.

Psalm 89:8 O LORD God Almighty, who is like you? You are mighty, O LORD, and your faithfulness surrounds you.

Psalm 89:14 Righteousness and justice are the foundation of your throne; love and faithfulness go before you.

Psalm 91:4 He covers me with his feathers, and under his wings I find refuge; his faithfulness is my shield and rampart.

Psalm 92:1-3

It is good to praise the LORD and make music to His name, O Most High, ² to proclaim your love in the morning and your faithfulness at night...

Psalm 100:4-5

I enter Your gates with thanksgiving and Your courts with praise; I give thanks to You Lord and praise Your name.⁵ For the LORD is good and his love endures forever; his faithfulness continues through all generations.

1 John 4:9-11 In this the love of God was made manifest to me, that God sent his only Son into the world, so that I might live through him. In this is love, not that I have loved God but that he loved me and sent his Son to be the propitiation for my sins. Because God so loved me, I also love others.

John 3:16 Thank you Lord that you gave your only Son, so that I who believe in Him will not perish but have eternal life.

Romans 5:8 Thank you God that you showed your love for me in that while I was still a sinner, Christ died for me.

Galatians 2:20 I have been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God who loved me and gave himself for me.

Ephesians 2:4-5 God, you are rich in mercy, and because of your great love for me, even when I was dead in trespasses, you made me alive together with Christ— by [grace](#) I have been saved. You raised me up with Christ and seated me with him in the heavenly realms in Christ Jesus,⁷ in order that in the coming ages you might show me the incomparable riches of your grace, expressed in your kindness to me in Christ Jesus.⁸ For it is by grace that I have been saved, through faith—and this is not from myself, it is the gift of God,⁹ not by works, so that I cannot boast.¹⁰ For I am God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for me to do.

Colossians 2:6-7 As I have received Christ Jesus the Lord, I walk in Him, having been firmly rooted and now being built up in Him and established in my faith, just as I was instructed, and I overflow with gratitude.

Gen 1:28 & 1:31 God blessed me and looked over me, His creation, and said I am very good...

Jer 1:5 Before God formed me in the womb He knew me, before I was born He set me apart.

John 10:10 The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; Jesus came to give me life, and life to the full.

James 1:17 Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights, who does not change like shifting shadows. (God is good ALL THE TIME!!)

Heb 6:19 Jesus is my living hope and the anchor for my soul, firm and secure. He enters the inner sanctuary behind the curtain. (Because of Christ I am able to have intimate fellowship with The Father and go into His inner courts).

Luke 1:37 For no word from God will ever fail.

Matt 6:33 I seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things are given to me as well.

Zephaniah 3:17 The LORD my God is in my midst, a mighty one who saves me; he rejoices over me with gladness; he quiets me by his love; he exults over me with loud singing.

Psalms 86:15 But you, O Lord, are a God merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love and faithfulness.

1 John 3:1 See what kind of love the Father has given to me, that I should be called a child of God; and so I am.

Deuteronomy 7:9 I know therefore that the LORD my God is God, the faithful God who keeps covenant and steadfast love with me who loves him and keeps his commandments, to a thousand generations...

**In conjunction with this last verse in Deuteronomy and to help you as you are meditating on any Old Testament scriptures, it is important to always be mindful of the new covenant through which we have been saved. This little paragraph is full of truth to help you get grace into your heart, and to help you understand that the promises of God showing up in our lives are no longer contingent upon man's obedience (because we have proven to always fall short), but that instead, through Christ, He alone is our contingency. His blood, His perfect sacrifice, His perfect obedience has redeemed us back into right standing with The Father for whosoever believes upon HIM and welcomes Him as their personal Lord and Savior. It is SO important that we KNOW this in our hearts at all times, especially during our intimate prayer time with God, so that the enemy cannot trip us up into thinking we are not worthy to receive because we fell short someplace. KNOW THIS: that God loves you UNCONDITIONALLY.

Here is a personalized confession to help you get this truth about being saved by grace into your heart:

I recognize as 2 Cor 5:2, Col 1:22, Heb 9:12, Romans 10:4. 1 John 2:2, Gal 5:1, etc. says, that Christ has fulfilled the law on my behalf, and through Christ, I am now and forevermore seen as holy and blameless and perfect in The Father's site at all times. He sees me as being ONE with Christ. He looks upon me and sees the blood of His son that covers me. I am in a new covenant with The Father through Christ that is no longer contingent upon my own works or obedience, but instead on Christ and His blood alone. Therefore the enemy has nothing against me and I do not believe His lies that I am unworthy to receive. My covenant relationship with God is not based on my own works, but on the work of Christ alone. Therefore all His promises are as His word says: yes and Amen to me in Christ (2 Cor 1:20), not because of what I have done or haven't done. God's position towards me is always of being for me and not against me ... Therefore I can confidently and boldly approach His throne of grace and mercy in my time of need (Heb 4:16). I choose to live by the Word and to love as God has commanded me to love, because He has first loved me and because His grace, which has saved me, teaches me to say no to ungodliness and sin and worldly passions and to live a self-controlled and upright life (Titus 2:12) I praise the Lord, however in knowing that even when I mess up, His love for me continues; God is not mad at me; He does not withhold from me; and He forever and always blesses me. I plead the blood of Jesus over my life and hate sin, but when it shows up, I do not let it entangle me...I simply repent and praise God that greater is He who lives in me than He who is in the world (1 John 4:4).

[Tit 2:12 NIV] 12 Grace teaches me to say "No" to ungodliness and worldly passions, and to live a self-controlled, upright and godly life in this present age...

[2Co 1:20 NIV] 20 For no matter how many promises God has made, they are "Yes" in Christ. And so through him the "Amen" is spoken by me to the glory of God.

[Heb 4:16 NIV] 16 I approach God's throne of grace with confidence, so that I may receive mercy and find grace to help me in my time of need.

[Col 1:22 NIV] 22 But now he has reconciled me by Christ's physical body through death to present me holy in his sight, without blemish and free from accusation--

[Heb 9:12 NIV] 12 He did not enter by means of the blood of goats and calves; but he entered the Most Holy Place once for all by his own blood, thus obtaining eternal redemption.

[Rom 10:4 NIV] 4 Christ is the culmination (fulfillment) of the law so that there may be righteousness for everyone who believes.

[1Jo 2:2 NIV] 2 He is the atoning sacrifice for our sins, and not only for ours but also for the sins of the whole world.

[Gal 5:1 NIV] 1 It is for freedom that Christ has set us free. Stand firm, then, and do not let yourselves be burdened again by a yoke of slavery.
