

Psalm 91 (ESV) - My Refuge and My Fortress –

- 91 I dwell in the shelter of the Most High
and I abide in the shadow of the Almighty.
- ² I say^[a] to the LORD, “My refuge and my fortress,
my God, in whom I trust.”
- ³ For he delivers me from the snare of the fowler
and from the deadly pestilence.
- ⁴ He covers me with his pinions,
and under his wings I find refuge;
his faithfulness is my shield and buckler.
- ⁵ I will not fear the terror of the night,
nor the arrow that flies by day,
⁶ nor the pestilence that stalks in darkness,
nor the destruction that wastes at noonday.
- ⁷ A thousand may fall at my side,
ten thousand at my right hand,
but it will not come near me.
- ⁸ I will only look with my eyes
and see the recompense of the wicked.
- ⁹ Because I have made the LORD my dwelling place—
the Most High, who is my refuge^[b]—
¹⁰ no evil shall be allowed to befall me,
no plague come near my tent.
- ¹¹ For he commands his angels concerning me
to guard me in all my ways.
- ¹² On their hands they bear me up,
lest I strike my foot against a stone.
- ¹³ I tread on the lion and the adder;
the young lion and the serpent I trample underfoot.
- ¹⁴ “Because I hold fast to Father God in love, he delivers me;
He protects me, because I know His name.
- ¹⁵ When I call to Him, He answers me;
Father God is with me in trouble;
Father God rescues me and honors me.
- ¹⁶ With long life Father God satisfies me
and shows me His salvation.”
