

## **Prayers when you need the truth to be brought into the light:**

### **John 3:21**

But whoever lives by the truth comes into the **light**, so that it may be seen plainly that what he has done has been done through God."

(In context, this talks about men who do evil hate the light and won't come into it in fear that their deeds will be exposed. But whoever lives by truth comes into the light, so that it may be seen plainly that what he has done has been done through God. It's a transparent place to live, but that's a good thing ☺. I always prayed that God would bring into light who I really was, when I was dealing with any gossip, when I had done something with the best of intentions and motives and it wasn't good enough, whatever . . . whenever you think there's something not true being thought or said about you, whether it's a believed lie of the enemy that you sense in the spirit has been dropped in someone's heart, or just simply that you know someone's heart is in need of repair, you can gain confidence in the word with this scripture that God's light will make the truth obvious. He will make it known to that person the deep love you really have for them, and the goodness you have within you, and the pure motives behind your actions.)

### **1 Corinthians 4:5**

Therefore judge nothing before the appointed time; wait till the Lord comes. He will bring to **light** what is hidden in darkness and will expose the motives of men's hearts. At that time each will receive his praise from God.

(In context, this talks about when the Lord comes he will bring light and expose the motives of men's hearts – so this light is like the "end times" final kind of light, but the verses that precede it and the concept apply to proving faithful being entrusted with the secret things of God, and when we know we are faithful, not worrying about what others think about us, not even judging ourselves for our mistakes, keeping a clear conscience and leaving it up to the Lord to expose the motives of our heart, not us.

### **Ephesians 5:13**

But everything exposed by the **light** becomes visible,

(In context, this is talking about living your life in the light of the Lord – the fruit of the light consists in all goodness, righteousness and

truth, about exposing fruitless deeds, and that light makes everything visible)

**Job 12:22**

He reveals the deep things of darkness and brings deep shadows into the **light**.

**Daniel 2:22**

He reveals deep and hidden things; he knows what lies in darkness, and **light** dwells with him.

(In context, this is one of many things mentioned that God does – giving praise to Him for it)
