

You Are a Divinely Inspired Living Being!

Hello My Resurrected Brothers & Sisters in Christ!

Yes, I am greeting you as my resurrected brothers and sisters in Christ, because you've been resurrected! Do you know what you've been resurrected from? Death. Death? Yes death. You may say, "but I haven't died yet, so how could I be resurrected from death?" Let's take a look at the scripture below:

[Gen 2:15-17 ESV] [15] The LORD God took the man and put him in the garden of Eden to work it and keep it. [16] And the LORD God commanded the man, saying, "You may surely eat of every tree of the garden, [17] but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat of it you shall surely die."

When God created man (male and female), he created us as LIVING spiritual beings and we were fueled by the very breath of God.

[Genesis 2:7 NIV] Then the LORD God formed a man from the dust of the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life, and the man became a living being.

That breath that God breathed into mankind was more than just hot air...it was a spiritual blast from God who is spirit, and that blast of His breath contained real, spiritual substance that He imparted from Himself into us. I picture something like that of a Superman movie where you can see the strength and power of that breath coming out of his mouth. That blast of breath from God's mouth into our nostrils gave us divine inspiration and intellect. Inspiration, as defined by the dictionary, is the process of being mentally stimulated to do or feel something, especially to do something creative. Intellect is understanding and mental power.

If you look up the Old Testament Hebrew word for breath, you will see it is: nesh-aw-maw' (Strong's Concordance H5395) and it means a puff, wind, angry or vital breath, divine inspiration, intellect or (concretely) an animal: - blast, (that) breath (-eth), inspiration, soul, spirit.

Anyone need some inspiration? Some mental stimulation to do something or feel something? How about some creativity? Some understanding? What about mental ability -- maybe the ability to store up the Word of God and His promises and quickly recall those things in your mind?

Would you believe me, or better yet, would you believe the Word that tells us all we need already exists within us as born again believers? Those who fear the Lord lack no good thing! (Psalm 34:9) It's not that we need more of something we don't already have; we simply need the knowledge and understanding of what is already inside of us and how to better access and release those things.

"Wait," you may say.."but we're not in the beginning of the garden anymore..." It's true, through the fall and the spiritual death that took place, it's like our hard drive was corrupted with a virus...called the deception of the enemy. So now how do we live as those divinely inspired living beings God created us to be? How can we see like God sees, have His understanding, or be stimulated like He desires us to be? You may say, "I'm not a very creative person..." Now I realize not all of us can draw or paint or sing or dance, but that's not all there is to creativity...In fact, those are very few examples that are just the tip of the iceberg when it comes to God's creative power that's at work in us. Yes, even in you!!! It's just the corrupt thinking of the enemy that has led you to believe a lie that you're not very creative.

The truth is you've been redeemed from the curse, and because of Jesus, you have now received the very Spirit and breath of God living inside of you again!

John 20:21-22: Again Jesus said to them, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent Me, so also I am sending you." When He had said this, He breathed on them and said, "Receive the Holy Spirit..."

Does that sound familiar?

The Greek word translated as "he breathed on" was only used once in the entire new testament in this place where Jesus Himself, just like Father God breathed onto the disciples and gave them the Holy Spirit.

"he breathed on" = emphusaō

From Strong's G1722 and φυσάω phusaō (to puff; compare G5453); to blow at or on: - breathe on. Total KJV occurrences: 1

God's Spirit is living in you and He MADE you; He made you a living, spiritual being - creative like Him. You're one with the creator!

As I said in the beginning of this email, you have been resurrected in Christ!!! You are no longer spiritually dead and there is no longer anymore disconnect!! Your emotions may try to tell you different, your friends may say different, your life may even look different, but if you are born again in Christ, the TRUTH is God has breathed on you and His very Spirit is alive in you and is empowering you in the same way He did when He raised Jesus from the dead! (Romans 8:11)

You are a divinely inspired living being! The next time you wonder about who you are or someone asks you to share a little about yourself...you can tell them about your job, you can tell them about your kids, you can tell them about what's going on in your life, OR you can at least first go to the thought in your head that: "I am God's divinely inspired living being!"

God created you to be a divinely inspired living being. He made you in His likeness and image, and He breathed into you His spiritual oxygen with real substance! Yes, there was more than just wind He was sending into your lungs. Your high school Chemistry teacher will tell you that the gas oxygen is required for you to breathe and to live as a natural human being. They will also tell you that even though you can't see it, it contains real physical substance. The same is true of the real substance contained within the spiritual breath of life from Father God...even though we can't see it, it contains, real spiritual substance.

Col 1:16: For in him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible...

Our minds have been so conditioned to consider only the visible, and in doing so, we are surely missing out on the greater part of creation that rules over that which is visible. I'm not even referring only to looking at the visible in the world around us and our circumstances, but more importantly, I'm speaking of the way we see ourselves!

To see real change in our lives and to bridge the gap of the feeling of "disconnect" between your spiritual reality as you know God has promised it and your natural reality, WE HAVE TO START SEEING OURSELVES IN THE INVISIBLE.

God sees what is in the unseen and He has given us His ability to do the same.

2 Corinthians 4:18: So we fix our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen, since what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal.

When you became born again, your spiritual eyes were opened and now you can see into the unseen realm. The question is, how much time and attention are we truly devoting to fixing our eyes onto the unseen and into those things that are eternal -- into the things the Word of God speaks of? Not with our natural eyes of course, but with our spiritual eyes...what we give time and attention to is what we deem as most important in our life.

Paul prayed for us and we can pray for ourselves this prayer as well..seeing the promise already fulfilled on God's end and ours in Christ, like every other promise in the bible. We pray the Word and bring our heart, mind and mouth into agreement so that what already exists inside of us in the spirit man is released into the natural. The place it can get caught up is in our soul (our mind, will, emotions and what we are consciously thinking about).

Ephesians 1:18: I pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened in order that you may know (SEE) the hope (CONFIDENT EXPECTATION) to which he has called you, the riches of his glorious inheritance in his holy people...

YOU HAVE EVERYTHING YOU NEED ALREADY INSIDE OF YOU IN CHRIST - SEE THAT!

Our Christian lives are not meant to improve our flesh, for we cannot!! The nature of the flesh is contrary to that of the spirit; therefore, it cannot be improved upon...it is instead meant for us to rule over it! It's just dirt...and we are called to rule over the dirt...to have dominion over the earth, starting with our own dirt!

I've been confessing lately that my spirit RULES over my flesh. We don't improve our flesh. We rule over it!

I want you to see that just like God gave to Adam and Eve in the beginning through His breath of life, He has given to us through Jesus Christ who redeemed us from our spiritual death and disconnect.

No matter how you feel, no matter what you are faced with presently in circumstance, I encourage you to pray like Paul prayed in Ephesians and to begin to fix your mind on what is within you in the unseen according to the Word of God...fix your mind on Christ who is the author and the finisher of your faith.

There is MUCH MUCH MORE I want to share and multiple pages I've already typed out, but I realize I don't want to overwhelm you in one post, so I'll wrap things up here and share more next time..for today, simply be mindful that God's Spirit is alive in you and you are a divinely inspired living being!! Your Spirit is full of God's inspiration, mental stimulation and creativity!

The way we access those things that are alive within us in the unseen, spiritual realm is simply by acknowledging every good thing that is already in us:

Philemon 1:6: I pray that your partnership in the faith may become effective as you fully acknowledge every good thing that is ours in Christ.

The gift of God's faith working in you becomes effective when you FULLY acknowledge every good thing that is yours in Christ, so start investing some time acknowledging those good things!
